



From the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 6

- vs 25-31 Read it first in a more literal translation, we'll read together from the Message translation.
- Put this section into context of chapter 6
 - What's Jesus been talking about?
 - •Who is Jesus talking to? Who is Jesus with?
 - •Where is Jesus? Is this at a particular time?

From the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 6

- 19-21"Don't hoard treasure down here where it gets eaten by moths and corroded by rust or—worse!—stolen by burglars. Stockpile treasure in heaven, where it's safe from moth and rust and burglars. It's obvious, isn't it? The place where your treasure is, is the place you will most want to be, and end up being.
- 22-23"Your eyes are windows into your body. If you open your eyes wide in wonder and belief, your body fills up with light. If you live squinty-eyed in greed and distrust, your body is a dank cellar. If you pull the blinds on your windows, what a dark life you will have!
- 24"You can't worship two gods at once. Loving one god, you'll end up hating the other. Adoration of one feeds contempt for the other. You can't worship God and Money both.
- 25-26"If you decide for God, living a life of God-worship, it follows that you don't fuss about what's on the table at mealtimes or whether the clothes in your closet are in fashion. There is far more to your life than the food you put in your stomach, more to your outer appearance than the clothes you hang on your body. Look at the birds, free and unfettered, not tied down to a job description, careless in the care of God. And you count far more to him than birds.

From the Gospel of Matthew, Chapter 6

27-29"Has anyone by fussing in front of the mirror ever gotten taller by so much as an inch? All this time and money wasted on fashion—do you think it makes that much difference? Instead of looking at the fashions, walk out into the fields and look at the wildflowers. They never primp or shop, but have you ever seen color and design quite like it? The ten best-dressed men and women in the country look shabby alongside them.

30-33"If God gives such attention to the appearance of wildflowers—most of which are never even seen—don't you think he'll attend to you, take pride in you, do his best for you? What I'm trying to do here is to get you to relax, to not be so preoccupied with *getting*, so you can respond to God's *giving*. People who don't know God and the way he works fuss over these things, but you know both God and how he works. *Steep your life in God-reality, God-initiative, God-provisions*. Don't worry about missing out. You'll find all your everyday human concerns will be met.

34"Give your entire attention to what God is doing right now, and don't get worked up about what may or may not happen tomorrow. God will help you deal with whatever hard things come up when the time comes.



Facts to Memorize:

- •87% of every dollar raised go straight to programming. The rest is overhead.
- •\$1 goes a long, long way. In many parts of the world, \$1 feeds a child for an entire day. *Don't have to give a lot.*
- Extreme Poverty is completely preventable. The world produces enough food to feed every person 2720 calories a day!
- •Every 3 seconds a child dies from malnourishment and/or preventable diseases
- •\$150 billion is the cost for every person in the world to have food, healthcare, education and safe water. N. American Teenagers spend \$155 billion a year on clothes, junk food, DVD's, music etc.


